### Services and Instruction

- Two Faculty librarians taught **22** library instruction sessions on three campuses in **Fall 2014** (ENG 101, ENG 102, IRW 095, COM 181, HIS 108, NSG 101, NAA 100, NPN 135, GEN 102) with **282 students** and **96 online students (378 total)**.
- Faculty librarians taught **19 sessions** in **Spring and Summer 2015** (ENG 101, ENG 102, COM 181, HIS 109, NAA 100, NPN 125, GEN 102) with **223 students** and **240 online students (463 total)**.
- Faculty librarians instructed with in-house-developed specific online subject/course guides and library tutorials for Foundations of Writing courses (ENG 101 and ENG 102); Reading courses (RDG 20/30) and Foundations of Learning (GEN 102) students.
- Faculty librarians were "embedded" in **50** MCTC Blackboard courses in Fall 2014 and **44** courses in Spring 2015, creating specialized content for each course.
- Provided Spring 2015 **Research and Writing Workshop Series** of 6 workshops for students at all campuses.
- Provided "**Stress-Free Zone**" for Spring Finals Week
- Course-specific reference assistance available
- Library and other scholarly information shared through

social media websites, i.e. Facebook, Twitter and Pinterest
