- More than 120,000 e-books available
- Streaming educational videos available
- Subject- and course-specific MCTC Library guides online
- Twenty-seven MCTC Library databases available by subscription in addition to 3 consortial databases through KCTCS and 16 Kentucky Virtual Library (KYVL) consortial databases

Services and Instruction

- Faculty librarians taught 29 library instruction sessions in Fall 2013 with 288 students and 88 students online (**376 total**).
- During Spring and Summer 2014, 11 instructional sessions were provided to 107 students and 160 online students (**267 total**).
- Faculty librarians have developed specific online subject/course guides and library tutorials for English 101 and English 102 courses, Reading and Writing students and Foundations of Learning (GEN) students
- Faculty librarians became “embedded” in a number of online MCTC courses within Blackboard over the past two years: 48 courses in Fall 2013, 41 in Spring 2014 and 9 in Summer 2014
- Course-specific reference assistance available
- Course reserves available upon faculty request
- Mini laptops and headphones available for in-house check-out
- Printing and photocopying available
- Library information shared through social media websites, i.e. Facebook, Twitter and Pinterest

- Fax and document delivery services to MCTC faculty and staff

Resource Usage

- 182,229 searches of electronic articles, e-books and other online resources
- 815 interlibrary loans requested and handled
- 3,340 check-outs at all three campus libraries
- 1,694 reference questions documented
- 3,175 directional questions documented
- 1,998 items used in-house
- 3,194 distance learning questions documented
- 59,413 trips made by library users into the three campus libraries
- 19,391 recorded logons to computers housed in three campus libraries
- 1,523 Student and Faculty/Staff ID cards created
- Hayswood Literacy Center (Maysville Campus): 80 writing consultations provided in Fall 2013, 38 in Spring 2014 semester
- Hayswood Literacy Center: 230 sign-ins in Fall 2013, 62 in Spring 2014

Physical Spaces and Staff

- Three campus libraries (Maysville, Licking Valley and Rowan)
- Two professional librarians with graduate degrees in library and information science from an American Libraries Association accredited program and five classified staff positions
- Open computer labs at Maysville and Licking Valley Campuses (computers available at Rowan Campus Library)
- 30,362 individual items available for check-out within all three campus libraries
