Notes:

- ▶ A GPA of 2.00 or better must be achieved in all college coursework (not just one class).
- ▶ Admission to the program is dependent on completion of BIO 137 and MAT 150 with a grade of "C" or better, and PSY 110.
- ▶ All students who apply to the Associate Degree Nursing Program must take the NLN Pre-RN Exam and attend one RN Pre-Admission Conference (per admission cycle) in order to be considered for admission.
- ▶ It is preferred, but not required, that general education and support courses be completed prior to admission to the Associate Degree Nursing Program.
- ▶ Good keyboarding skills are required in order to meet the computer literacy requirement.
- ▶ A grade of "C" or higher must be achieved on all program required science and nursing courses.
